- **‘Impact and Institutions of Spanish Colonization’- Seminar Paper (2017)**

With the assistance of my mentor: Our paper on ‘Impact and Institutions of Spanish Colonization’ attempted to trace the process and impact of Spanish colonization on current economies while comparing it to other former European colonies.

After studying and reviewing approximately 20 published research papers, we concluded that the nature of the colony did have a major influence on its subsequent economic, social and political development, providing proof of divergence across economies. And the extractive nature of Spanish colonies had a detrimental impact in terms of low GDP and PCI for the colonised countries.

- **‘Effect of the Changing Political Ties of India and China on their Bilateral Trade’- Research Paper (2017-2018)**
